

# Southern Victoria Village Council Meeting

Monday, November 10th, 2025

Present: Mayor McLaughlin, Deputy Mayor Shaw, Councillors - Sheila Cummings, Paul Legace, Tami McPhail, Sara Plant, Todd McGuire, and Assistant CAO Justine Waldeck.

- 1) Mayor McLaughlin called the meeting to order.
- 2) No conflicts of interest were declared.
- 3) It was **MOVED** by Councillor Cummings that the October Meeting Minutes be approved. **SECONDED** by Councillor McPhail. **MOTION CARRIED.**
- 4) The RCMP representative addressed questions from Council regarding ongoing community issues. When asked if there were any ways Council could assist in supporting their work, it was suggested that the municipality consider hiring a by-law enforcement officer to handle matters such as noise complaints, as the RCMP do not have the authority to issue fines in those cases. The RCMP noted that while staffing levels are currently slightly below full strength, one or two new cadets are expected to join the Perth detachment in the near future. It was also noted that officers are on duty 23 hours a day, ensuring consistent coverage throughout the community.
- 5) The new transmission line project is 100% complete
- 6) A letter was received from DTI requesting information on the municipality's priorities for road construction projects for the 2027/28 fiscal year. Council agreed to review DTI's 2026/27 commitments before providing a response.
- 7) The following reports were presented - Municipal Administration/Strategic Plan Update, Water Consumption Reports, Quarterly Financial Statements, and Fire Department Report.
- 8) Councillor Plant **MOVED** that Council accepts the Letter of Approbation – New Library Members. **SECONDED** by Councillor Cummings. **MOTION CARRIED.**
- 9) Councillor Cummings **MOVED** to move in-camera to discuss Fiscal and Development Issues. **SECONDED** by Councillor Plant. **MOTION CARRIED.**
